1.0 Introduction

The NPA's quarterly downstream petroleum statistical bulletin provides statistical information on key indicators of the downstream petroleum industry, including crude oil prices, petroleum product prices, petroleum products supply and demand, stock situation, and Bulk Import Distribution and Export Companies (BIDECs)/refineries performance statistics. The information contained in this bulletin is intended to assist downstream industry players, academia, students, and policymakers in making informed decisions, as well as to support research activities.

2.0 Crude and Refined Product Prices

Brent crude oil prices traded within a range of US\$61.74/barrel to US\$86.55/barrel per pricing window during the first quarter of 2026. Refined product prices on the international oil market traded between US\$361.11/MT and US\$1,290.11/MT per pricing window for the same period. Table 1 presents the average FOB prices of Brent crude oil and refined products for the period under review.

3.0 Domestic Prices

3.1 Ex-Refinery Prices

Table 2 presents the estimated bi-weekly average ex-refinery prices of petroleum products (petrol, diesel, and LPG) for Bulk Import Distribution and Export Companies (BIDECs) for Q1 2026. Prices are denominated in Ghana cedis per litre (GHS/Lt) except LPG, which is priced per kilogram (GHS/Kg).

4.0 Petroleum Products Stock Situation

At the end of the first quarter of 2026, diesel had the highest stock of petroleum products across depots nationwide, while kerosene had the lowest. Table 5 shows the stock position on the opening and closing days of the First Quarter of 2026.

5.0 Petroleum Products Supply

5.1 Imports

An estimated 1,339,717 metric tonnes of petroleum products were imported during the first quarter of 2026. Table 6 details the volume of each product imported over the review period, along with a year-on-year comparison to Q1 2025.

Additionally, **426,625 metric tonnes** of crude oil were imported for the period under review.

5.2 Domestic Production By Refineries.

An estimated 380,528 metric tonnes of petroleum products were refined domestically during the first quarter of 2026. The substantial increase in domestic production compared to Q1 2025 was due to Sentuo Oil Refinery Limited's active operations during the quarter. Table 7 presents the total domestic production of petroleum products for the period.

6.0 Petroleum Products Demand

6.1 National Demand

A total of 1,678,795 metric tonnes of petroleum products were supplied to the Ghanaian market during the first quarter of 2026. Table 8 provides a full breakdown by product category across the three months of the quarter.

6.2 Regional Demand

Table 9 shows the regional demand for petroleum products for Q1 2026. As expected, Greater Accra recorded the highest consumption at approximately 26.66% of total products consumed nationally, while the Oti Region recorded the lowest share at 0.72%. 7.0 Petroleum Service Providers (PSPs) Market Share

7.1 Bulk Import Distribution and Export Companies (BIDECs)

The performance of BIDECs during the first quarter of 2026 reveals that the top ten companies collectively accounted for 75.88% of the market, while the remaining BIDECs and refineries held the remaining 24.12%. Overall, a total of 47 BIDECs and refineries were active during the quarter under review. Detailed performance statistics are provided in Table 12.

7.2 Petroleum Product Marketing Companies (PPMCs)

Table 13 presents the performance statistics for the top 20 Petroleum Product Marketing Companies (PPMCs) during the first quarter of 2026.
